General Information

The purpose of the Metro 3A Volleyball Tournament is to determine a *league champion* and seed our teams into the SeaKing District 2 championships. Nine (9) teams will advance to the district championships on November 10 and 12 where they will begin bracket play according to the result of league tournaments in Metro and KingCo.

Tournament Policies and Regulation

The tournament shall be governed by the WIAA rules and regulations, Metro, SeaKing District 2 policy, and NHFS Rules. Lacey London (Holy Names Academy) will act as Tournament Director and Brent Brakke (Lincoln High School) will serve as Assistant Tournament Director. The Tournament Directors will be empowered to make decisions deemed necessary that are not specifically addressed in these instructions. Any item for consideration by the Tournament Committee must be submitted to the Tournament Director or the local Site manager.

Tournament Committee:

If a protest occurs and a ruling is required, then the Tournament Chair will assemble a Tournament Committee, which will consist of the following:

1. Head Official or Designee
2. Lacey London - Tournament Director
3. Two (2) head coaches not involved in the protest. This will be determined once a protest is filed.

Play will commence with the Pledge of Allegiance or National Anthem.

Roster and Pass List

Each participating team must submit a team roster and pass list to Lacey London by **Saturday, October 29**. This information will be used for the program and for admission to the tournament. Please email your roster and pass list to llondon@holynames-sea.org Attention Lacey London -Volleyball. Roster and pass list changes may be made prior to the first match. No changes are permitted at the league level once the tournament begins (WIAA Rule 22.3.0).

Schools must submit pass list or key personnel will be required to pay for their admission.

Admission

All spectators except children under 6 are required to pay an admissions fee. Please communicate the information to your fans prior to the tournament so they will come to the tournament prepared to pay the admissions.

Cheerleaders in uniform will be admitted free.

Passes

WIAA, WOA, District 2, Metro, and KingCo Lifetime passes are the only passes that will be honored. Specifically, League Faculty and District passes will not be honored. The head volleyball coach and/or Athletic Director of non-participating schools will be admitted free if their names are submitted to the Tournament Director.

Each Team will be limited to fourteen (14) players, six (6) designated school personnel (coaches, managers, statistician, etc.), one (1) medical personnel, and two (2) supervisory personnel. The names must be listed on the pass list. Those not on a pass list will not be admitted without a ticket.

Team Arrangements

There is ample room in the Main Gym for general warm-up and stretching purposes. Valuables are the team's responsibility. Do not leave valuables unattended. Team members, coaches, the manager, and a statistician are the only personnel that will be permitted on the team bench during match play.

Spectator Arrangements

Team supervisors are responsible to see that their spectators behave in an orderly and sportsman-like manner in compliance with gym rules. The following general rules will be strictly enforced at all sites.

1. Artificial and or mechanical noise makers **are not** permitted.
2. Confetti **will not** be allowed. Schools violating this policy will be assessed a clean-up fee.
3. **No flash photography** will be allowed during play at any time on either court.

Bands

Bands are permitted at Metro League tournament games. School Athletic Directors must notify the Site Manager if a school band will attend the tournament game. All band members must be accompanied by their school supervisor and appear on the pass list turned into the Site Manager.

Match Format

All games will be rally scoring to 25 points (no cap) with the 5th and deciding game being 15 points (no cap.). All matches will be best 3 out of 5 games. This is the same scoring format that will be used at the District and State Tournament. Each School will provide their own practice/warm-up balls.

Team Benches

Teams will not change benches between sets.

Linespersons/Scorekeepers/Libero Tracker

Linespersons will be provided by the Greater Seattle Volleyball Officials.

Scorekeepers will be provided by the Greater Seattle Volleyball Officials.

Libero Tracker and Scoreboard Operator – each school must be prepared to provide a libero tracker or scoreboard operator for each match. Your volunteer should be qualified to do either job.

Warm-Up

Warm-up time for the first round on each day of the tournament will be 20 minutes, with 8 minutes of shared court time, followed by six minutes for the visiting team, followed by six minutes for the home team. Hitting and serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared team. Teams are not allowed to warm-up on the sidelines or end lines while waiting for their court time.

Note: Following a match and when a team must play consecutive matches, they will be provided up to 20 minutes of rest before official warm-up will begin.

Game and Warm-Up Balls

Each School will provide their own practice/warm-up balls. The higher seeded team will provide the game ball and be the home team for that match.

Medical and Athletic Training

There will be a Certified Athletic Trainer present for site medical services. Taping can be done by the ATC, but each school will need to provide its own supplies. Ice and water will be available in the gym to all participants.
