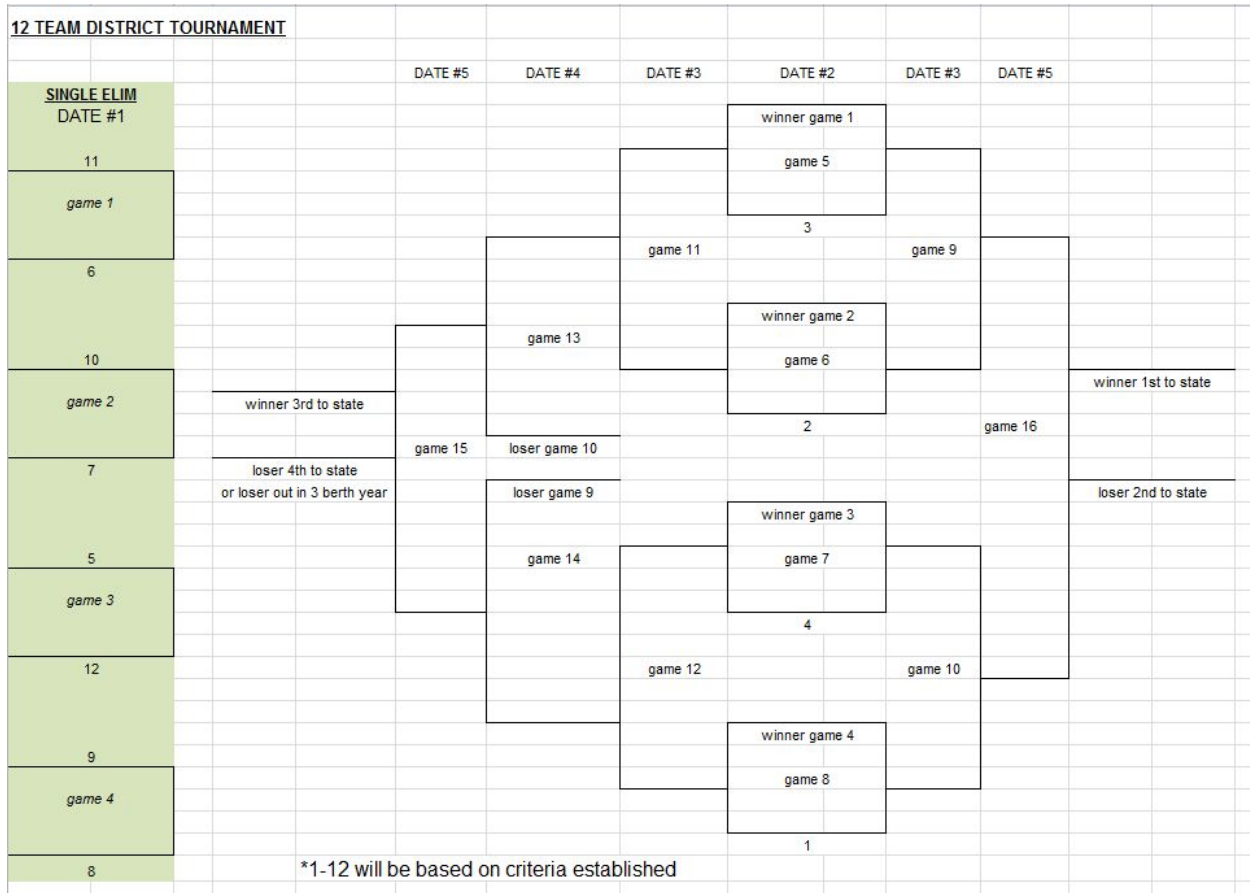

NOTE: *In a 4 berth year, game 15 will not be played. Games 13, 14, and 16 at one site on Saturday. (Revisit after allocations are determined). The RPI will determine the number 3 and number 4 seeds to State First Round. In a 3 berth year, game 15 will be played as it will eliminate a team.

Football Agreement:

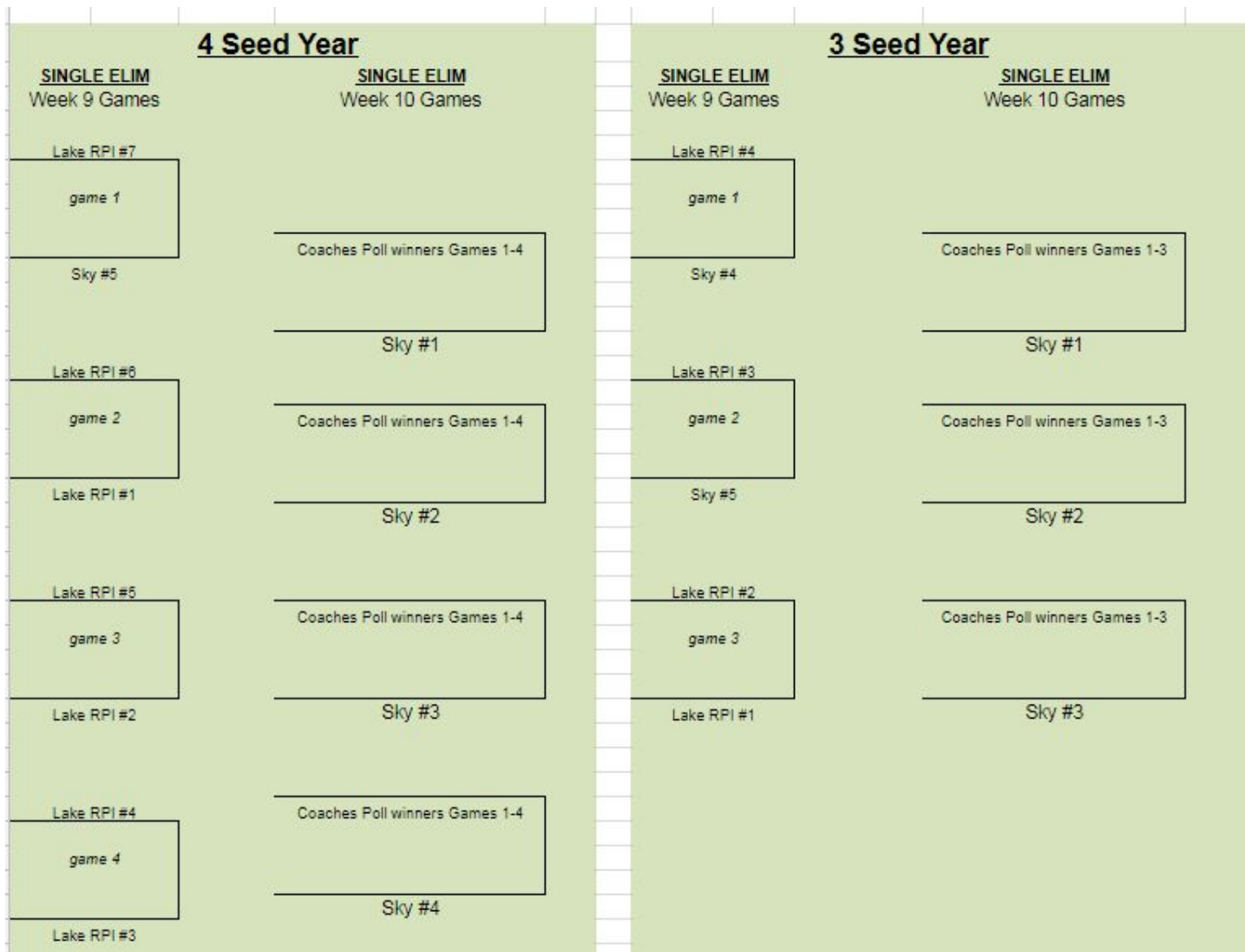
Determining Week 9 Games:

- The Top five schools in SKY Division will all have entry into the post-season starting in Week 9 of the football schedule. The Top 3 schools in the SKY division in a 3 berth year will get a BYE in Week 9. Top 4 schools in the SKY Division in a 4 berth year will get a BYE in Week 9.
- In a 3 berth year, SKY Division teams #4 and #5 will get the first two spots in the Week 9 playoffs. In a 4 berth year, SKY Division team #5 will get the first spot in Week 9 playoffs. The remaining spots in both the 3 and 4 berth years will be based on RPI finish. (Note: For RPI purposes: Liberty, being in the Top Tier in the KINGCO will earn 3A RPI points. Sammamish being in the Middle Tier of the Metro will received 2A RPI points)
- For the purposes of breaking a tie for the last spot into the playoffs, the RPI will take in account the non-conference games winning percentage and opponents records.

Determining Week 10 Games:

- To determine the games in Week 10 on who will play the Top 3 schools in the SKY division in a 3 berth year or Top 4 schools in the SKY Division in a 4 berth year will be based on a coaches poll.
 - Schools involved in Week 9 post-season and the schools that have the BYE will submit Polls.
 - In a 3 Berth year it would be 9 schools submitting a Coaches Poll.
 - In a 4 Berth year it would be 12 schools submitting a Coaches Poll.
 - Coaches/Athletic Directors (1 poll per school) will submit by Friday at midnight of Week 9.
 - In order for a coach to not be able to manipulate the coaches poll, we will throw out the high and low vote for each coaches submission and can not vote for their own school.

- Results will be sent out ASAP on Saturday morning in order for coaches to be able to prepare for their Week 10 opponent.



MINUTES FOR DETERMINING MOVEMENT IN THE NWC TIERS PORTION OF THE MEETING

1. Review Tier Breakdown formula
 - a. 20% 2 year RPI Ave.
 - b. 20% Roster size Ave. for 2 years.
 - c. 20% Seniors lost Ave. for 2 years.
 - d. We eliminated win/loss percentage.
 - e. 40% on 1 year coaches poll.
2. We will review annually. Every year we will change the schedule. Changing of schedule by team moving up and a team moving down will cause teams to play non-league opponent.
3. We will use formula to determine the movement of teams. Teams will be forced to move up or down in the middle of a two year cycle. A team may have a choice to stay in the Top tier at the end of a two year cycle.
4. Coaches Polls voting for the Tier Formula will be submitted at the All-Conference Selection meeting at the end of the season.
 - a. Coaches poll will be submitted after discussion from each coach sharing how many seniors their will be losing, outlook for the following season, and general perspective.

*NWC Football Coaches other discussions:

1. We will have our Pre-Season Coaches Football Meeting on Tuesday, August 14th the day before first practices.
2. Question: How will SKY and LAKE Divisions for All-Conference Teams be handled? Advised to submit ideas to athletic directors before June Workshop to discuss.
