

#### 4A District One/Two Bi-District Agreement

##### A. Formation of agreement

1. Athletic administrators of KingCo and Wesco served on the Bi-district Agreement Committee
2. The committee members processed proposals through their respective conferences to receive general support.
3. The committee's goal was to develop an agreement that provides a fair, equitable, and exciting post-season experience for student-athletes and the communities each conference serves.

##### B. Qualifying for Team Tournaments

1. In years when teams play for 5 state berths, KingCo #1-7 and Wesco #1-5 will advance to the bi-district tournament.
2. In years when teams play for 4 state berths, KingCo #1-6 and Wesco #1-6 will advance to the bi-district tournament.

##### C. Qualifying for Individual Tournaments/Meets

1. Swimming- Each District will host its own District meet.
2. Cross Country- Each District will host its own District meet.
3. Golf- Each District will host its own District tournament.
4. Tennis- Each District will host its own District tournament.
5. Wrestling- The state regional format will be used.
6. Track- Each District will host its own District tournament.

##### D. Bracketing

1. Twelve (12) team brackets will be utilized for all team sports. Brackets will be modified for each sport.
  - a. Softball and Volleyball will utilize a 12-team double elimination bracket.
  - b. Soccer will utilize a two-tier bracket where KingCo #1 and 2 and Wesco #1 and 2 occupy a 4-team bracket with losers moving into a slot in an 8-team bracket with the other seeds.
  - c. Baseball and Basketball will utilize a 12-team bracket where the first round is single-elimination.
2. 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> place game-
  - a. This game will only be played if RPI is used for seeding into the state tournament.
  - b. When RPI is not used, third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place will be the team with the higher seed in the tournament. In the event the two teams have the same seed, third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place shall be assigned to KingCo in 5-berth years and Wesco in 4-berth years.

##### E. Tournament sites

1. Tournament sites were identified and agreed to by members of both Districts.
2. Game locations shall be adjusted to accommodate match ups and reduce travel when possible and necessary. Changes shall be made by agreement of the Bi-District Committee.

F. Games committee

1. Each tournament game or site shall identify its games committee per WIAA guidelines. Each games committee shall have a minimum of three (3) members with at least one member representing each District. Exceptions to members on the committee may be made through agreement of the Bi-District Committee.

G. Advancing to state

1. The tournament champion and runner-up shall each receive designation as a #1 District berth to the state tournament (per WIAA email confirmation).

H. Financial

1. The net profit and loss of each tournament shall be shared equally among both Districts.
2. Finances for each phase of each tournament shall be managed by the District in which the host school is a member.
3. Each District shall pay all expenses associated with games played at schools in the respective District.

I. Ticket prices/Passes

1. Ticket prices are \$7 for adults and students without ASB cards. Students with ASB cards, seniors, and children will be charged \$5.
2. Accepted passes
  - a. Washington State Coaches Association passes.
  - b. Washington Secondary Schools Athletic Administration passes.
  - c. Washington Officials Association
  - d. District One and KingCo "Supervisor Passes". These passes may be used at 4A Bi-District events at KingCo and Wesco sites.
  - e. District One and KingCo "Lifetime Passes". These passes may be used at 4A Bi-District events at KingCo and Wesco sites.

J. Tournament bulletins

1. A tournament bulletin template shall be developed by athletic administrators of each District.
2. Sport tournament specific bulletins shall be developed in cooperation of members in each league, utilizing the template as a guide.

K. Officials

1. Officials for each tournament game shall be assigned by the District in which the game is held. Each District shall use its own process to assign officials.

L. Awards

1. The bi-district team champion shall be awarded a trophy. District 2 shall provide the trophy in the 5-berth year. District 1 shall provide the trophy in the 4-berth year.

M. Addressing of grievances

1. In the event either District feels this agreement or components of tournaments do not meet the needs and expectations of either party, a committee of members from each District shall meet to address any and all grievances. This agreement was negotiated in good faith and each party trusts the other to work collaboratively.
