III. Games Committee: The Games Committee shall consist of the tournament manager, the head official, and a participating coach, athletic director or school administrator not involved in the dispute in question. If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation of misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question, and prior to the resumption of action, that the contest is being played under protest. At that point the official(s) will suspend the contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately. The coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the tournament officials, and desired outcome. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session. The decision of the Games Committee is final.

VII. Admission:

- A. Ticket Prices: All tickets sold at the door.
\$7.00 Adults, Students w/o ASB
\$5.00 Students with ASB, Children, Senior Citizen
- B. Passes: **Supervisors should use their District's approved pass. WSSAAA, WIAA, and WSCA passes are also accepted.**
- C. Cheer Squads of participating schools will be admitted in their uniforms.
- D. **ROSTER & PASS LIST**: The team roster will serve as school's pass list. The playoff roster must be entered on the WPA website by Thursday, October 25. The roster should include the names of the players (14 maximum), 6 designated school personnel, which includes, coaches, managers, statisticians, etc. 1 licensed health care provider/trainer for a total of 21 maximum people on your bench. School board members & Superintendent should also be listed on your roster. **Supervisors should use their District's approved pass. WOA, WSSAAA, WIAA, and WSCA passes are also accepted.**

VIII. Officials:

- A. Officials will be provided by the location of each tournament match.
- B. Lines people will be assigned by the officials association)
- C. Scorekeepers will be provided by the participating schools.

IX. Awards Policy:

- A. A team trophy will be presented to the first place finisher.
- B. There will be a short presentation ceremony at the conclusion of the championship game.

X. General Information:

- A. Table Help: The score keeper, Libero tracker, and score board shall be run by the home team in the match (bottom of the bracket). Each team shall provide the names of the adults who will assume these rolls in the event they are needed. People working the tables are volunteers and will NOT be charged admission.
- B. Volleyballs: The host school will be responsible for furnishing 3 NFHS approved game balls.
- C. Pre-match warm up
1. First round matches of the day will have 20 minutes of warm-up time with the home team getting 6 minutes, visitors 6, home 4 and visitor 4. (Home team on the bottom of the bracket) Second round matches in the same day will get 14 minutes of warm-up. Home team gets 7 minutes, then visitors gets 7 minutes. No more shared court time for warm-ups.
 2. Gyms will open 1 hour 15 minutes before matches begin.
- D. Opening ceremonies (tournament sites): For the first match, the entire roster of both teams will be introduced.
1. The teams are to line up in front of their respective bench. As names are read, each player is to take one step forward and remain standing.
 2. The starters are to be introduced last and as their names are called they are to run to the end line of the nearest court.
 3. After all teams are introduced the announcer will lead the fans and players in the pledge of allegiance, or national anthem.
- E. Team bench: The bench area is to be restricted to the 14 players, coaches and managers.

F. Match play: Matches will consist of the best 3 out of 5 games.

XI. Sportsmanship:

A. Positive signs and school banners will be permitted.

B. Artificial noisemakers will not be permitted in the gyms.

C. The faculty supervisors from participating schools are to check in with the gate attendant.

XII. Rules and Eligibility Policies:

A. Each participating team must enter their playoff team roster on the WPA website, using the roster feature, by **Thursday, October 25th**, with the 14 members who will participate in the tournament.

B. Changes may be made any time prior to the first match of the tournament and before each round when rounds occur on different days.

XIV. Locker Rooms: Girls' locker room will be available for use all evening, no locks, no supervision and athletes are to provide their own towels.

XV. Concessions will be available.
