

WIAA Northwest District One/Two 2022 2B District Volleyball Tournament

Tournament Bulletin

The purpose of the Northwest District One 2B Volleyball Tournament is to seed District One teams into the state Volleyball championships. One (1) team will advance to the state championships

Three teams qualify to participate in the District Tournament, two (2) from the Cascade Northwest Conference, and one (1) from the Sea-Tac conference.

District Tournament play is divided into one day and the format will be a single elimination bracket completed on the same day. The first round of the bracket play is the play-in round for the District Championship between District 1 #2 seed vs. District 2 #1 seed. The winner of the play-in round will play District 1 #1 seed in the championship round.

Winner Advances
- **November 2nd Match times 6:45 PM @ La Conner(Championship Round)**
Winner G1 vs. D1 #1
Winner advances to the State Tournament.

Tournament Policies and Regulations

The tournament shall be governed by the WIAA rules and regulations, Northwest District One policy, and NFHS rules. Each site will appoint a Tournament Committee which will be empowered to make decisions or judgments deemed necessary that are not specifically addressed in these instructions. Any item for consideration by the Committee must be submitted to the Tournament Manager or the local Site Managers.

Directions to Site

- Directions to La Conner High School: (305 N 6th St, La Conner, WA 98257)

(Driving into La Conner) Take the first round-about into La Conner. Drive on the main street to 6th street. Take a right, and follow the road all the way to the end. Buses please park in the far side of the car parking lot. All spectators will park in the upper lot at the front entrance of the gym.

Bus Parking:

- La Conner High School-All buses enter the first right (next to the gym). They then drive towards the furthest side by the gate to park.

Admission Policies:

Ticket Prices:

Adults, Students w/out ASB..... \$8.00 High School Students w/out ASB..... \$6.00 Children, Senior Citizens (age 62 and older)..... \$6.00

Passes:

District One Event Supervisors Pass will be the only ones accepted for admission. People using the **Event Supervisor pass** are expected to take an active role in their crowd management.

*Regular District One Supervisory Passes are NOT valid for postseason admission.

Eligibility:

- The school must be a member of the WIAA and enrolled in volleyball for the current year
- A participating student must meet all eligibility requirements set by the WIAA
- All players must be certified by the principal at the first state-qualifying tournament
- Official uniforms must be worn for all contests

General Guidelines:

- The tournament director will furnish scorekeepers and lines people at site
- No signs may be posted with the exception of the school banner, which must be approved by the tournament director.
- Noisemakers are not allowed
- The bench area is restricted to the teams, coach, and managers.
- Teams may not provide their own warm up music.
- Concessions will be available throughout the tournament.

• The tournament director is empowered to make any decisions or judgments deemed necessary, that are not specifically covered by this bulletin

Gymnasium:

• The gymnasium will open one hour prior to the start of the first game of the day.

Home Team:

• The home team is the higher seed, if no higher seed, then the bottom team in the bracket is the home team.

Locker Rooms:

- Locker rooms will be available for each participating team. Please check in with the tournament director or event manager upon arrival.
- Security of all valuables is the responsibility of the participating school.

Warm-Ups:

• 20 Minutes provided for your first game of the day: 8 minutes shared, 6 minutes home team, 6 minutes visiting team. Warm-ups will start 30 minutes prior to the start of the first game of the day.

Match Schedule:

• It is the coaches' responsibility to see that their team is near their assigned playing court at least 15 minutes prior to their match time

Pre-Game Ceremony:

- Welcome – WIAA sportsmanship announcement.
- The Pledge of Allegiance / National Anthem will take place prior to the first contest of the day.
- Introductions will take place before each contest.

Officials:

• The NW District Board will assign all officials for the District Tournament from the following associations: S.C.B.V.O and the N.W.B.V.O

Rosters:

- Each team may have a roster of 14 players. Postseason rosters must be uploaded to the WPA Roster Center by Monday, October 31st. **IN ADDITION**, you must fill out the pass list on the document at the end of this bulletin and return it to CJ Woods by Monday, October 31st. Both must be done by 3:00am on October 31st.

- There will be no roster changes after this deadline (as per WIAA Rule 25.3)

Tournament Ball:

- Baden volleyball will be provided for game balls. Each school is responsible for their own warm up volleyballs.

Ground Rules:

- Ground rules will be explained at each site by the tournament manager or head official.

- The tournament committee shall consist of the tournament director, the head official, a Sea-Tac representative and a northwest conference representative.
